

POLICY NO. 30-170

SUBJECT: YARD LIGHT CONTRACT

1. The consumer agrees to pay the Cooperative for service hereunder at the rates and upon the terms and conditions set forth in Schedule OL, outdoor lighting.
2. The Cooperative shall maintain and furnish all of the electric power and energy necessary for the operation.
3. The Cooperative will furnish necessary material to install lamps. If a pole is necessary the consumer shall pay the cost of labor, overhead and pole.
4. In the event of rental property, this contract shall be co-signed by the property owner.
5. This contract shall remain in force for five (5) years.
6. The Consumer shall report to the Cooperative failure of yard light. The Consumer shall protect the lighting equipment from deliberate damage.
7. The consumer does grant the Cooperative a right-of-way necessary to maintain the yard light.
8. It is understood and agreed that the rates as set forth in the aforesaid Schedule OL are rates in effect as of the date of this agreement. From time to time changes in rates may be adopted pursuant to the By-Laws, rules and regulations of this Cooperative. When such rate changes are so adopted (whether an increase, decrease or otherwise) they shall be set forth in a new Schedule OL attached hereto and the newly adopted rates shall be the rates effective under this agreement.
